ELLIS Manchester is committed to fostering diversity and inclusivity in research and acknowledges the financial challenges faced by researchers from economically disadvantaged backgrounds. To address this issue, we are pleased to announce our “**ELLIS Manchester Scholarship**”, aimed at providing financial assistance to applicants from a minority group facing economic hardships during their research pursuits.

This funding can cover the summer school registration fee and accommodation for up to three nights during the summer school.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be currently enrolled in a PhD program or PDRAs in earlier career development from a minority background. Financial needs must be demonstrated. Commitment to contributing to diversity and inclusion in their respective fields.

Please describe your circumstances briefly with no more than 500 words to tell us about you, your research and to demonstrate the need of financial support to attend, email ellis@manchester.ac.uk by **17th April 2025*** with the subject “**ELLIS Manchester Scholarship for disadvantaged participants**”.

The ELLIS Manchester Steering Group will judge each application on its own merits and will make decisions soon after the deadline closes.
